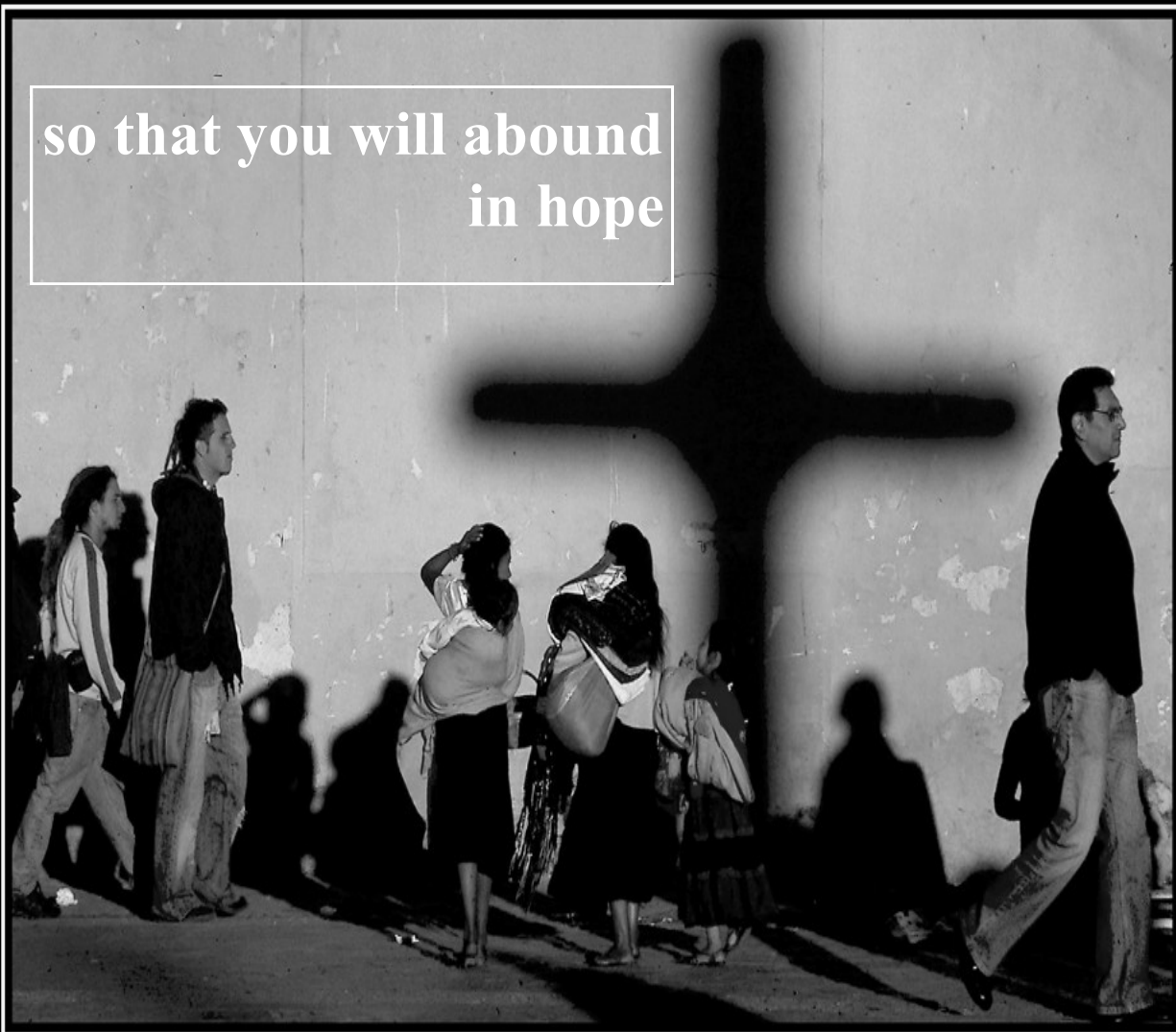

Rich's Review

For whatever was written in earlier times was written for our instruction, so that through perseverance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

Romans 15:4

Patience is a hallmark of faith. As God revealed His promise to Abraham in Genesis there was a “wait” attached to the fulfillment. When the Lord brought Moses and the Hebrew people out of Egypt, He told them to “stand by” and see His deliverance. The whole of the Old Testament is a fore-teller of Christ’s appearing.

For over 1,000 years the presence of God was represented in the middle of Israel as Moses built the Tabernacle, followed by Solomon’s Temple. Every ceremony, every offering depicted the promise of God to redeem His people. The divinely given plans set the articles of worship and sacrifice in shape of a cross.

Jesus’ appearing fulfilled the promise of Messiah, the Anointed One. Sinless in life and lamb-like in death, Jesus’ cross speaks hope to the world. As Paul wrote to the Romans, hope requires endurance. The ability to endure life with hope is the encouragement of the Scriptures. As Paul also wrote our strength is Spirit given.

Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you will abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. Romans 15:13

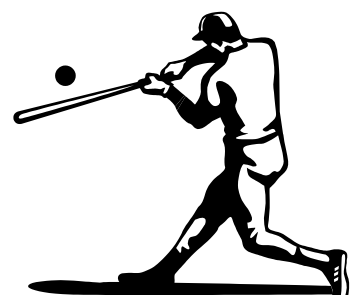
