



Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse: Training for Mandated Reporters

The State of Illinois has mandated training for all those who work with children both paid and volunteer. This is a new law that came into effect this year.

The training is free and can be done online at the DCFS website. DCFSTraining.org is the site and you click on "Mandated Reporter Training" that will take you to the training module.

The training takes about an hour to complete and you will be able to print out a certificate that you completed the training at the end of the course.

It is a very important aspect of ministry to our church and community that all those involved in ministry to children have completed this training. Sunday School Teachers, VBS Helpers, Nursery Workers are all included.

You can contact the church office or Pastor Dave for more information and help completing the training.

This is a great witness to our community that we truly love them and their families.


